Suddenly one day, there's a strange spot on my body.

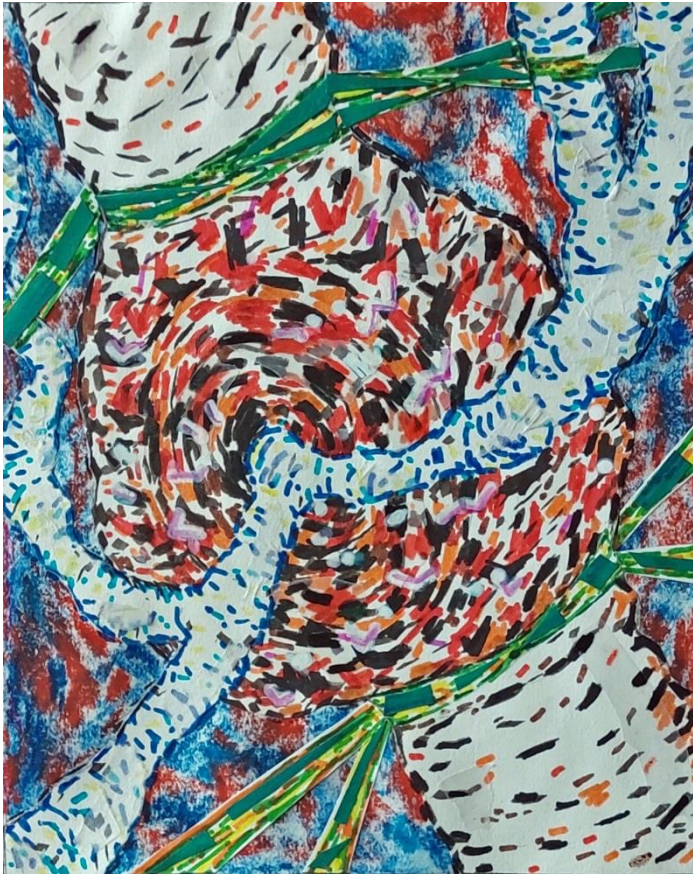


What's this?
